Join us for a cruise along Surrey's beautiful River Wey on board the 'Harry Stevens'. Trips start from Guildford Boat House, just along from the Yvonne Arnaud Theatre (follow the signs).

The trips offer the chance to enjoy this ancient navigation with its varied wildlife as you travel through some of the most attractive countryside Surrey has to offer. The on-board commentary allows you to find out much more about the River Wey and its history.

We run regular trips in season for individuals: please see the calendar on the reverse of this leaflet for details of trips, which are subject to river conditions.

If you would like to reserve your seats to be sure of space on a public trip, please contact us on the morning of the trip, or for 10 or more, make a Small Group booking in advance.

Large Group bookings (for 30-60 people, and subject to availability) need to be made at least 14 days in advance, and can be arranged for different times and routes. Please ask for our "River Trips for Groups" brochure.

A 1½ hour trip heading south from Guildford Boat House taking in St Catherine's lock and the history and beauty of the Godalming Navigation section of the River Wey. Turning at or near* the Gun's Mouth (junction with the old Wey & Arun Canal) the trip brings you back to the Boat House.

The Harry Stevens

A purpose-built, open-sided craft giving the best view of the river and countryside. Roll-down blinds keep out the rain if we run out of luck with the weather. Capacity 60.

The River Wey

The River Wey Navigation was opened from the Thames at Weybridge to Guildford in 1653, one of the first waterways to be 'canalised' making it suitable for large craft. In 1764 the Godalming Navigation opened from Guildford to Godalming, completing the 19½ miles of today's River Wey.

Guildford Boat House

Family owned and run, this central Guildford operation gives you access to the River Wey in lots of ways: trips on the Harry Stevens, meals aboard the Restaurant Boat 'Alfred Leroy' (for large or small groups – please ask for details), rowing boats and canoes, and of course our fleet of luxurious holiday Narrowboats for a weekend, week or longer away from it all.

Group Bookings

Harry Stevens: available every day except Mondays and Fridays, minimum 30 people. Ask for our 'River Trips for Groups' leaflet.

Alfred Leroy: lunch, afternoon tea and evening cruises with menus to suit all tastes and pockets for 25 people or more.

Now also booking for Saturday Dinner & Sunday Lunch on selected dates for single table bookings.

How to find us

Guildford Boat House: by car, follow the signs for Guildford Town Centre, then leave on the A281 Horsham Road. Fork left into the High Street for the Yvonne Arnaud Theatre and Millbrook Car Park, 1st right into Quarry Street, right at the traffic lights at the end of Quarry Street then left into Millbrook Car Park. You will see the entrance at the far end. From Horsham direction on the A281, simply turn left into Millbrook Car Park.

Guildford main line station is approximately ½ mile.
